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**DEAR
TEACHERS:**

Since the Provincial Firefighters Consortium Museum opened its doors in June 2011, it has always kept in mind that, among its functions, divulgation and accessibility are essential to making every visit a rich educational experience. This is how the educational program we present below for the 2026–2027 school year comes about each year.

MuBoma is a museum with a unique theme in the Valencian Community, dedicated to the profession of firefighters—both men and women—from its origins as a volunteer brigade, and approached from a historical perspective to trace its evolution through an original museography featuring authentic artifacts from the late 19th century and the first half of the 20th century, such as various water pumps, uniforms from different eras and styles, tools, and even vehicles—including a century-old Chevrolet. Furthermore, both the building itself (a former factory from the mid-19th century) and the first part of the exhibition take us back to the history of industrialization in the city of Alcoy.



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We believe that the best way to highlight and raise awareness of this preserved heritage in an enjoyable and engaging way is through guided tours and educational activities tailored to the needs of each group of visitors.

MuBoma is located at 64 Alcassares Street; it is accessible by bus, and there is parking available. Access to both the outdoor and indoor facilities is very easy for adults and children alike, and there is also an elevator inside for people with limited mobility. There are seating areas in the audiovisual spaces where visitors can rest during their tour.



In addition, very close to the museum is a green area along the banks of the Riquer River, developed as a riverside promenade with a playground.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Payment must be made in cash or by credit card on the day of the visit.
- For bank transfer payments, the transfer must be made several days prior to the visit, and proof of payment must be sent before the group's arrival.
- Visits typically last 1 hour, and workshops last approximately 20 minutes.
- Reservations must be made at least 15 days in advance.
- For health and hygiene reasons, it is not possible to stay for lunch on the museum grounds. Only breakfast is available in the morning.
