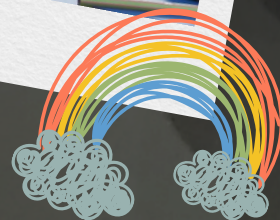

**DEAR  
TEACHERS:**

One more course we present the MuBoma (Fire Museum of the Provincial Consortium of Alicante), the only museum dedicated to firefighters in the Valencian Community.

The first thing you will find when you arrive at the museum is an old factory that talks about the history of industrialization in the city of Alcoy during the 19th and early 20th centuries. In addition, along the three floors, the original exhibition narrates its relationship with the history of the fire, the origin of the firefighters and the evolution of those first brigades that worked entirely voluntarily. A series of original pieces that have been recovered and restored are complemented by numerous videos scattered throughout the tour. Uniforms, masks, water pumps and original fire vehicles from the first half of the 20th century, such as the most prominent piece, a 1921 Chevrolet, will be one surprise after another.



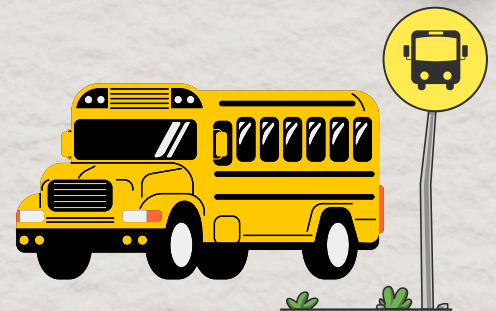

Guided tours and educational workshops are the best tool to value the heritage that houses the MuBoma de Alcoy and to allow people to know it in a fun and entertaining way. These are always adapted to the characteristics of the received group.



The MuBoma is located on Alcassares Street number 64; it can be reached by bus, with space for parking. The access to exterior and interior facilities is very easy for adults and children, also having an elevator inside for people with reduced mobility. It has seating areas, in spaces with audiovisuals, to rest during the tour.



It is also interesting to know that there is a green area close to the museum on the banks of the Riquer River, enabled as a river walk with a children's playground.
